



**FAMILY REUNIFICATION VISA – CHILDREN OF ITALIAN/EU CITIZENS OR CHILDREN OF
THE SPOUSE OF AN ITALIAN/EU CITIZEN
NATIONAL VISA – TYPE "D" (MORE THAN 90 DAYS)**

CHECKLIST

- 1. VISA APPLICATION FORM:** Download and complete the [National Visa application form](#). Please do not leave any fields blank; indicate "N/A" where a question is not applicable. *For minors, the application form must be signed by **BOTH** parents.*
- 2. PHOTOGRAPH:** One (1) recent [ICAO](#)-compliant colour passport-size photograph (3.5 × 4.0 cm), with a white background and both ears visible.
- 3. TRAVEL DOCUMENT:** Current valid passport (and any previous passports, where applicable). The passport must remain valid for at least three months beyond the expiry date of the visa requested. A remaining validity of at least six months is recommended, as required by the Philippine Bureau of Immigration.
 - a. Photocopy of the passport biodata page, the last page, and all pages containing visas and entry/exit stamps from any country.
- 4. INVITATION:** Invitation letter (the relevant form may be downloaded [HERE](#)), duly completed and signed by the Italian/EU parent(s).
- 5. DOCUMENTATION ESTABLISHING THE STATUS OF THE ITALIAN/EU CITIZEN FAMILY MEMBER RESIDING IN ITALY:** Legible photocopy of the Italian/EU passport of the parent(s).
- 6. PROOF OF FAMILY RELATIONSHIP:** Original and photocopy of the applicant's birth certificate issued by the NSO, authenticated by the DFA within the previous six (6) months, and officially translated into Italian.
 - a. Photocopy of the marriage certificate extract issued by the Municipality of residence in Italy, or evidence of transmission of the marriage certificate registration to the Italian Municipality through the Consular Section. For spouses of other EU citizens, a marriage certificate registered in the relevant EU Member State must be provided.

- b. **FOR MINORS:** Affidavit of Consent from the other parent, together with a copy of a valid identity document. Where a parent is deceased, an NSO-issued death certificate legalised by the DFA must be provided.

Where the applicant is a descendant of an Italian/EU citizen (or of the spouse of an EU citizen) and is over 21 years of age, proof of financial dependency must be provided.

- 7. **PROOF OF RESIDENCE IN THE PHILIPPINES:** Copy of a valid residence document.
- 8. **VISA FEE:** No fee applicable.

Visa applications cannot be accepted if the intended date of travel is more than six months after the date on which the application is submitted.
